Morris Beja in his book Film and Literature (1979) estimated that, "roughly 30 percent or more of all films produced each year were based on novels and the sixteen out of twenty highest grossing films ever were adaptations drawn from novels." Another film scholar, Charles Bane made an observation that the most recent edition of Enser's Filmed Books and Plays (2017) include Eight thousand films released during the period 1928 to 2001 were based on novels or plays. Dudley Andrews mentioned that "half of the blockbuster films had adapted from the literary work". This shows the popularity of film adaptations from literary sources. The novels are particularly adapted to films due to the novel's global acceptance. According to Balzac, the novel should be regarded, as a potential raw 'material to be transformed at will by the writer of the screenplay. He says that the screenplay has the capacity to approach reality, to approach the thematic and the formal design of the literary model and represent it with a viewpoint incorporation. represent it with a viewpoint incorporating a new aesthetic design and technology, creating thus a new artistic version. For instance, Tolkien's Level Chi. version. For instance, Tolkien's Lord of Rings, Stephen Mayor's Twilight, J K Rowling's Harry Potter are classic literary works. The readers or fans of such books are a major reason for film adaptations. Films derived from literary works, particularly novels, are also considered visual literature. Films employ both the visual and verbal forms in their spoken modes, but literature forms in their spoken modes, but literature exclusively uses semantic formation in its writing.
